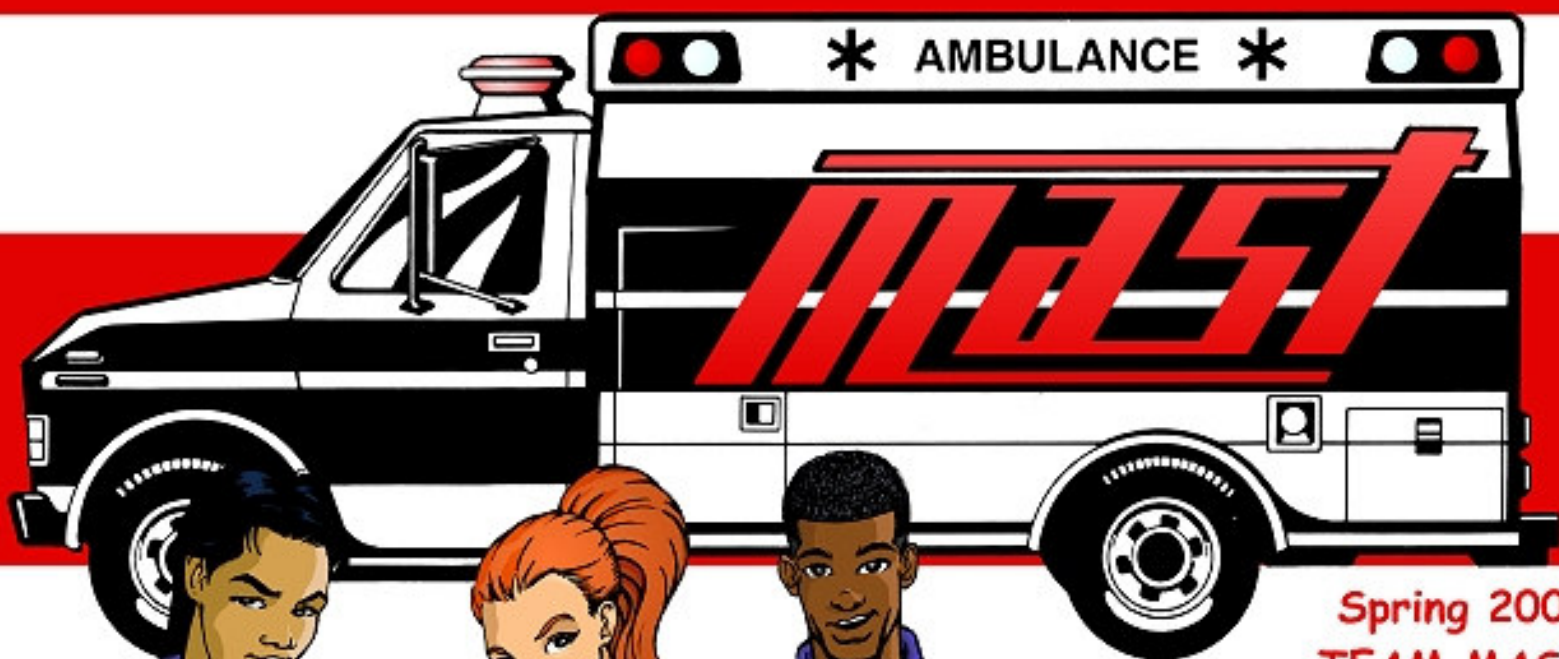
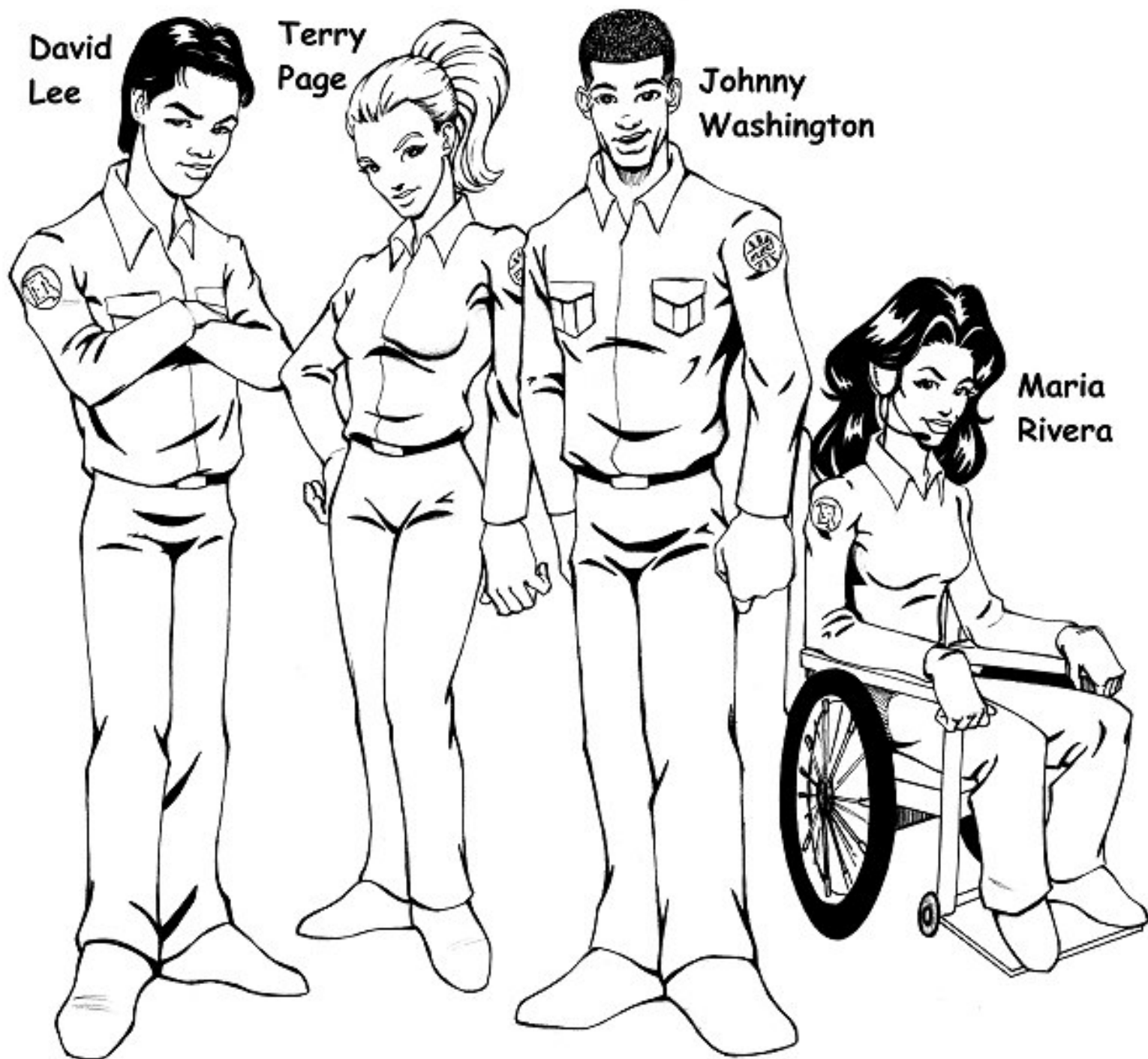

Terry's job as an EMT (Emergency Medical Technician) is to provide emergency medical treatment much like a doctor that sustains life before transporting the victim to the Hospital's Emergency Room. Johnny is our paramedic. His job is to assist Terry, and to provide limited medical treatment. David the MST's job is to help with braces, bandages and breathing assistance, and when someone is in a difficult location, he secures their injuries before they are moved. Maria is the 911 Emergency Dispatcher; she receives emergency calls from MAST Headquarters then relays directions to the MAST Ambulance. The MAST ambulance TEAM is here to deliver emergency medical treatment to victims of car accidents, fires, home, and sports injuries right to the victim at the scene of the accident.

So, remember boys and girls, if you see someone who is injured call 911 and have your name, location, and description ready to report and stay on the line until we arrive and you too can be an emergency medical hero, just like TEAM MAST!

and he won't wake up!


I'm sending help right away!

Never touch a weapon you find!


If you ever find a gun, never pick it up. Instead, leave it there and go find your parents or an adult to handle it!
